Geographic Information Systems Technology The GIST Programs offers in-person and online degrees at the bachelor's, master's, and graduate certificate levels. Our programs are classified as STEM degrees (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) and integrate GIScience, cutting-edge GISystems, and geospatial technology with management and problem-solving skills, to prepare you to use GIS in a variety of business, government, non-profit, and academic settings.



ONLINE BS-GIST

The BS-GIST degree is a 120-credit hour bachelor degree program, offered through UAOnline. BS-GIST students take 14 classes in their major, training students in GISystems and Technologies, basic programming for GIS, and application of GIS&T to web and mobile environments.

ONLINE MS-GIST

The online MS-GIST is an accelerated 18 month, 30 credit-hour program. Our interactive learning elements, online discussions, and other enhanced student services ensure a vibrant and highly successful learning community. Students can enroll for the Spring (January) and Fall (August) semesters.

IN-PERSON MS-GIST

The in-person MS-GIST degree is offered weekday evenings, to accommodate the busy professional. This 18 month program accepts students in January and has a 92% placement record in the geospatial industry.

ONLINE GRADUATE CERTIFICATE

The post baccalaureate certificate is a graduate 9 credit-hour program that is taken online. Students completing the PGIST certificate can be taken online or in-person or use them as a graduate minor in another UA degree.
